Our Pastors, Tim and Cindy Russell, are travelling abroad the next couple of months via the Lily Grant they were awarded. Our Missions Spotlights are going to be countries that they will be in at some point in the month. As we pray for these specific countries, let's continue to lift up our travelling pastors as well.

## FRANCE

There were 66.81 million people in France in 2015. Though CIA Factbook states that 60-63% of those millions would describe themselves as "religious" (mostly Catholic), this is a country torn. Only 1.8% of this number are actually practicing. Several times in France's history, the Catholic Church became the countries only, and governing, religion. This was the case for most of the nineteenth century. The law eventually separating church and state came in December of 1905.

However, as Olivier Roy from the European University Institute of Florence stated, "In America, separation was designed to free religion from state interference, whereas in France separation has evolved to exclude religion from public space and to promote the supremacy of the state over religious organizations."

In a time plagued with terror attacks and uncertainty, the population of France remains wary of organized religion. Rather they would see integration and tolerance in their country, keeping faith relegated to home and church buildings.
