What is Persecution? Christian persecution is the systematic mistreatment of an individual or group of individuals because of their Christian faith. It can come in the form of physical abuse, torture, rape, mutilation, destruction of property, imprisonment and murder. It can also come in the form of cultural and societal discrimination, family excommunication, loss of job and income, loss of family and friends, inability to marry, prevention of education and many other forms.

Facts on Persecution:

- Christians are the most persecuted group in the world.
- Every month, 322 Christians are killed for their faith in Jesus.
- 200 million Christians are facing persecution on a regular basis.
- Every month, 214 Christian churches and properties are destroyed.

- Pray that Christians would continue to shine for Jesus and share their testimony to their persecutors with boldness.
- Pray that the churches in the United States would grow in awareness and support of persecuted Christians.
